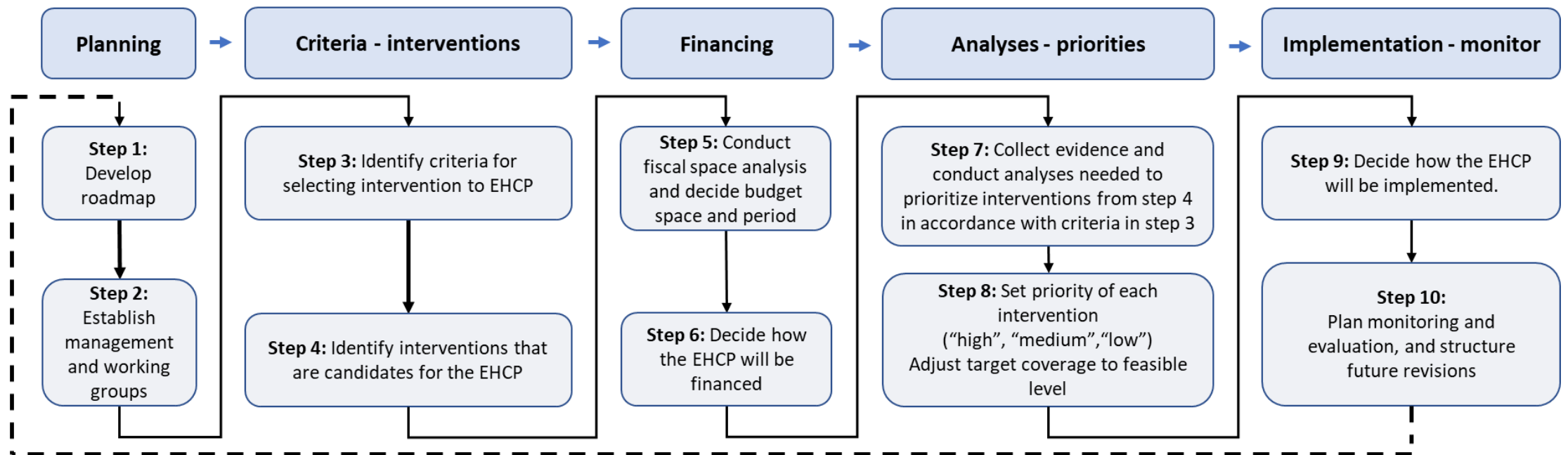

10-step strategy process for fair essential health care package priority setting process

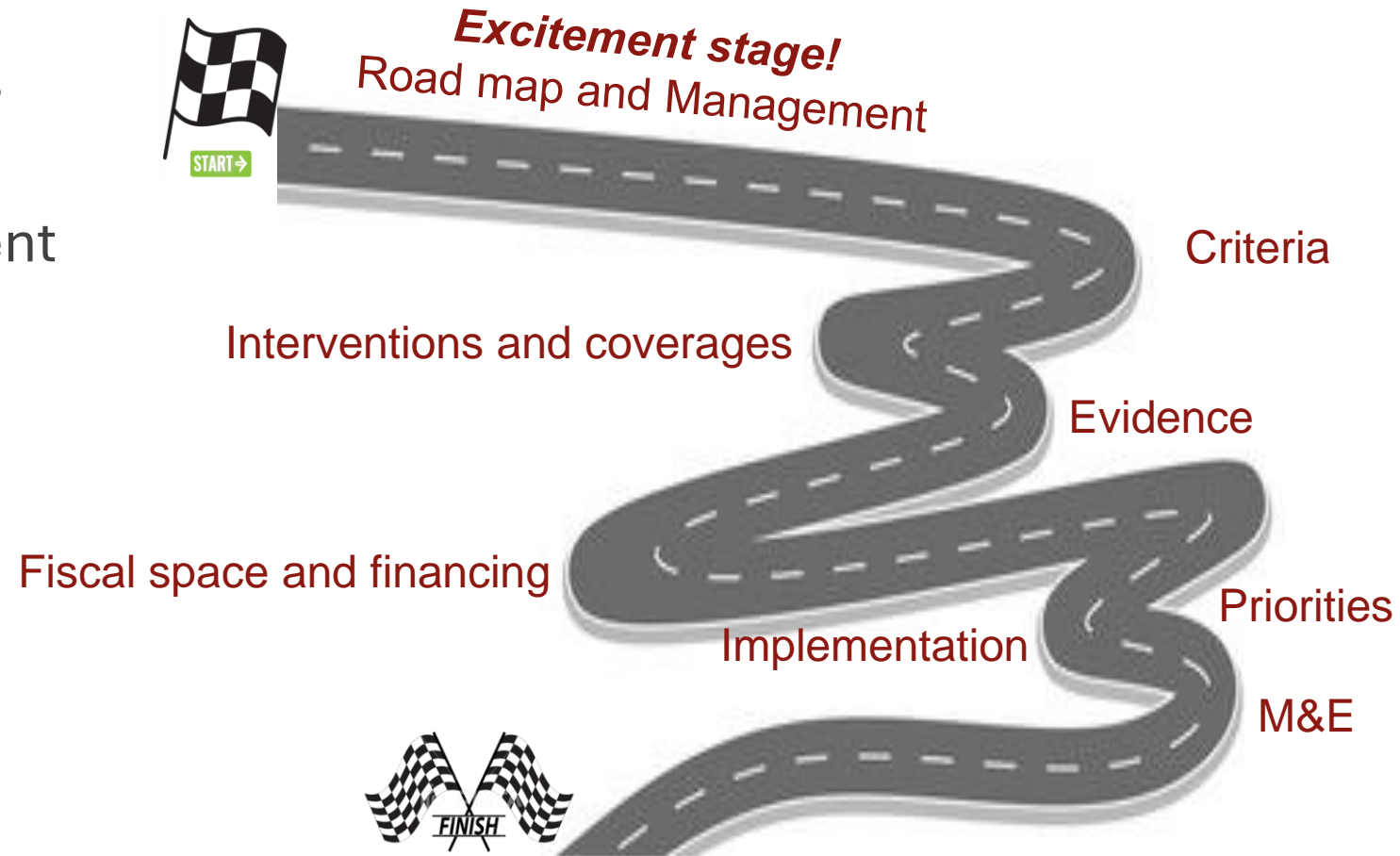
Three principles that apply for all steps:

1. Involvement of relevant key stakeholders
2. Transparency about decisions and their rationale, and the development process
3. Deliberation - thoughtful examination of different perspectives, arguments, and information to arrive at a well-informed decision

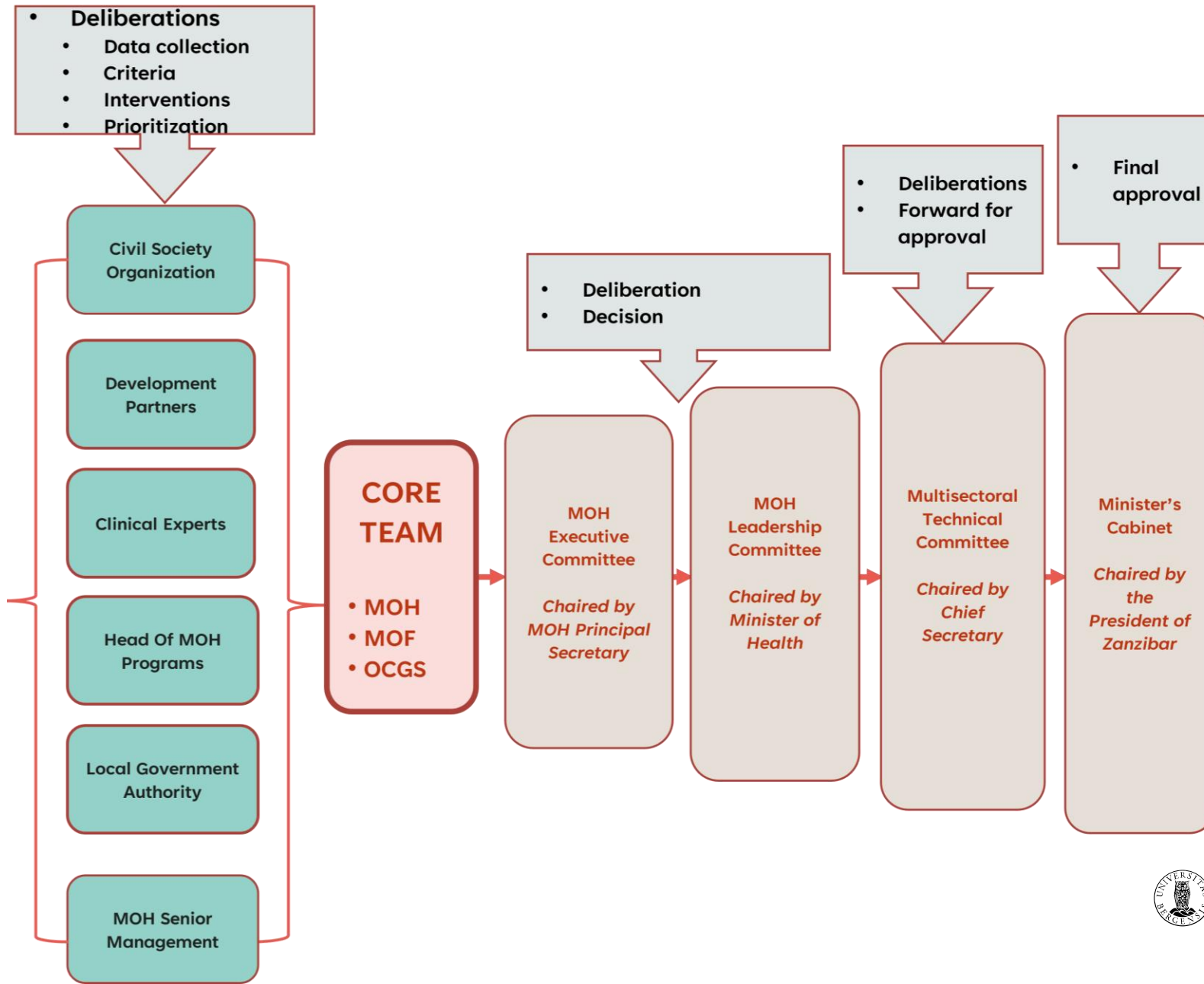


The “real” implementation of the process!
